The Name

The word Huellas means fingerprints and is our way of reminding us that all of our work in the vineyards results in an impact on the land and the community. We must respect that and limit those impacts to beneficial impacts as much as we can.

The Label

The image of the wing of a butterfly echoes our commitment to the biodiversity and the ecosystem that our vines live in.

The Vintage

A fairly early vintage, with hot weather throughout the growing season. We started the harvest at the end of August, with manual picking progressing rapidly through the bush trained vines to get all the grapes in rapidly. A harvest that once started was fast and non-stop.

The Winemaking

After a fastidious pass on the sorting table, we 100% destemmed, performed only a light crush, and then straight to a temperature controlled stainless steel fermentation with minimal and gentle pumpovers, then the free run was racked into used larger format barrels (a mix of 300, 400 and 500 liters) for 8 months prior to bottling in 395g bottles.

The Wine

A blend of mainly Carignan with Grenache, this is a powerful wine, but still showing the perfume and elegance of the Poboleda region. Enjoyable on release, but we recommend putting some bottles into your cellar to open on the 10 year anniversary of the vintage.
